Lipszyc family purchased the house in 1913. In July of 1924 Helena Kowalska (later known as St. Faustina) found herself in Warsaw. Fr. Jacob Dabrowski, parish priest of St. Jacob, and before that, he was in Klembow, he sent Helena to Aldona Lipszyc in Ostrowek, who accepted her to work as a maid-servant. Her duty was to care for the house and for the four children. In this way, Helena was able to earn for her trousseau, which was demanded at that time before entering the convent. On Sundays and Holidays of obligation, she attended Holy Mass in nearby Klembow. She fulfilled in an exemplary manner the work entrusted to her. She was treated as a member of the family and it was hard to part with her after a year. Mrs. Aldona recalls: *I remember her healthy, joyful laughter. She used to sing a lot and when I think of her, it reminds me of a song which she sang most often: "Hidden Jesus" which I learned from her. Now that I learned about her vocation, I understood the meaning of this song*

in her life. She appeared to be healthy, cheerful, and even jolly. She had a smooth, reddish-hair, plaited in big braids, nice, bright, and calm a bit freckle-faced.

On August 1, 1925, Helena entered the Congregation of Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy at Zytnia Street in Warsaw and received the name Faustina.

St. Faustina recollecting her time spent in Ostrowek noted: *God filled my soul with the interior light of a deeper knowledge of Him as Supreme Goodness and Supreme Beauty. I came to know how very much God loves me. Eternal is His love for me. It was at vespers. In simple words, which flowed from the heart, I made to God a vow of perpetual chastity. From that moment I felt a greater intimacy with God, my Spouse. From that moment I set up a little cell in my heart where I always kept company with Jesus. (Diary 16)*
